What is the IJB?

The IJB is the Perth & Kinross Integration Joint Board for Health and Social Care services. The IJB is a key decision-making body in shaping how services are delivered

The overall goal of the IJB is that all people have a positive experience of health and social care services and that they are planned and delivered in ways that are joined-up and person-centered

What is a Public Partner?

The IJB has four volunteer public partners. The role of the Public Partners is to bring a service user and a carer perspective to the IJB in planning the future of Health and Social Care Services across Perth and Kinross.

They have representation on several strategy groups such as the Strategic Planning Group, Carers Strategy Group and Mental Health.
